**For Reflection and Discussion:**

1. According to Ephesians 1:1-6, what is the goal and purpose of God's saving election? What ramifications does this truth have for everyday life?
2. What is Holiness? What does it mean to be blameless? In what or in whom does Holiness originate? (Read Isaiah 6:1-7, 1 Peter 2:9-10, Colossians 1:21-23 for further discussion and reflection)
3. Read Psalm 15. Can anyone achieve that standard of Holiness? If the answer is no, where then is our hope? (Read 2 Corinthians 5:17-21)
4. The hope offered by Jesus in the Gospel ought to bring great comfort. But with that comfort comes a calling and obligation? What is the obligation of the believer in the pursuit of holiness (Read Romans 8:1-17 & 1 Peter 1:13-16)
5. Finally, what are some practical ways we can pursue holiness? There were 5 mentioned in the sermon...
